

ThinkFree Server Standard

ThinkFree Server Standard is an online version of ThinkFree Office. Both ThinkFree Server Standard and ThinkFree Office suite share the same core technology but there are a few key differences.

Note that since we use a Java applet for our Office launcher, it is possible to run on a variety of operating systems and various browsers as well.

ThinkFree Server Standard has unique advantages such as supporting an on-demand mode, thin clients and ASP. For example, it is possible to do the following:

1. Use the on-demand mode that does not require any installation on the client side.
 - Users can stay anonymous. Therefore it is suitable to be used in locations such as government offices, libraries, schools, airports and bus terminals.
 - It is also ideal for places that need to reformat the computer OS systems regularly to protect against virus infections and for efficient resource management.
2. Enhanced system security is controlled by a centralized ACL (Access Control List)
 - Access to recordable devices (i.e. Floppy disks, USB memory sticks) can be limited. You can also control the user's file open and save locations.
 - Documents can be displayed through a read-only viewer mode to prevent editing a document.
 - Prohibit printing feature to prevent information leakage.
 - It's suitable for places where demand has to have a high level of document security with compatibility.
 - Unique attractive point as an Online Office suite
 - The web friendly interface projects a technical-oriented company image to the customers.

ThinkFree Server Integrator

ThinkFree Server Integrator possesses a versatile "On-Demand" mode which makes it possible to open and save documents located within systems such as internal groupware, ERP, CRM, or online board seamlessly.

Integrator includes an online office suite, like ThinkFree Standard Server, and extra features such as the ability to remotely save and open documents to the administrator's desired repository.

1. Immediately open and save MS office formatted documents that are stored in ERP systems or in an internal groupware. It's also possible to embed into current web-pages upon request.

- To open office file format reports and applications forms, there is no need to convert files to image files such as to .swf and .pdf formats.
- The office files can be displayed in a new window or embedded in the current html page.

2. Open files running on an FTP server, WebDav, protocol services. It's also possible to navigate with the file dialog to save the file to desired locations.

- It is possible to open templates and save them to desired locations by using ThinkFree Server, if it is integrated to websites that provide document templates.
- If ThinkFree Server is integrated with collaboration services, ability to open, edit and instantly save shared documents.
